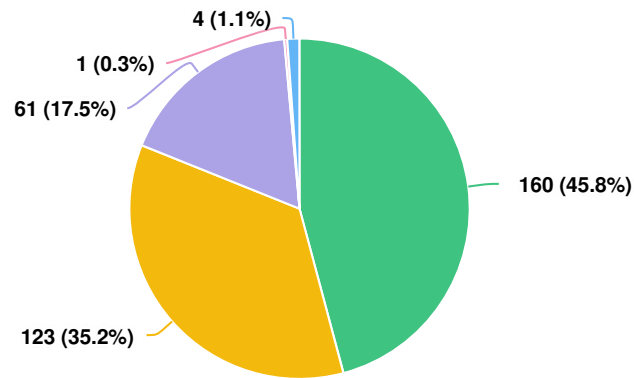

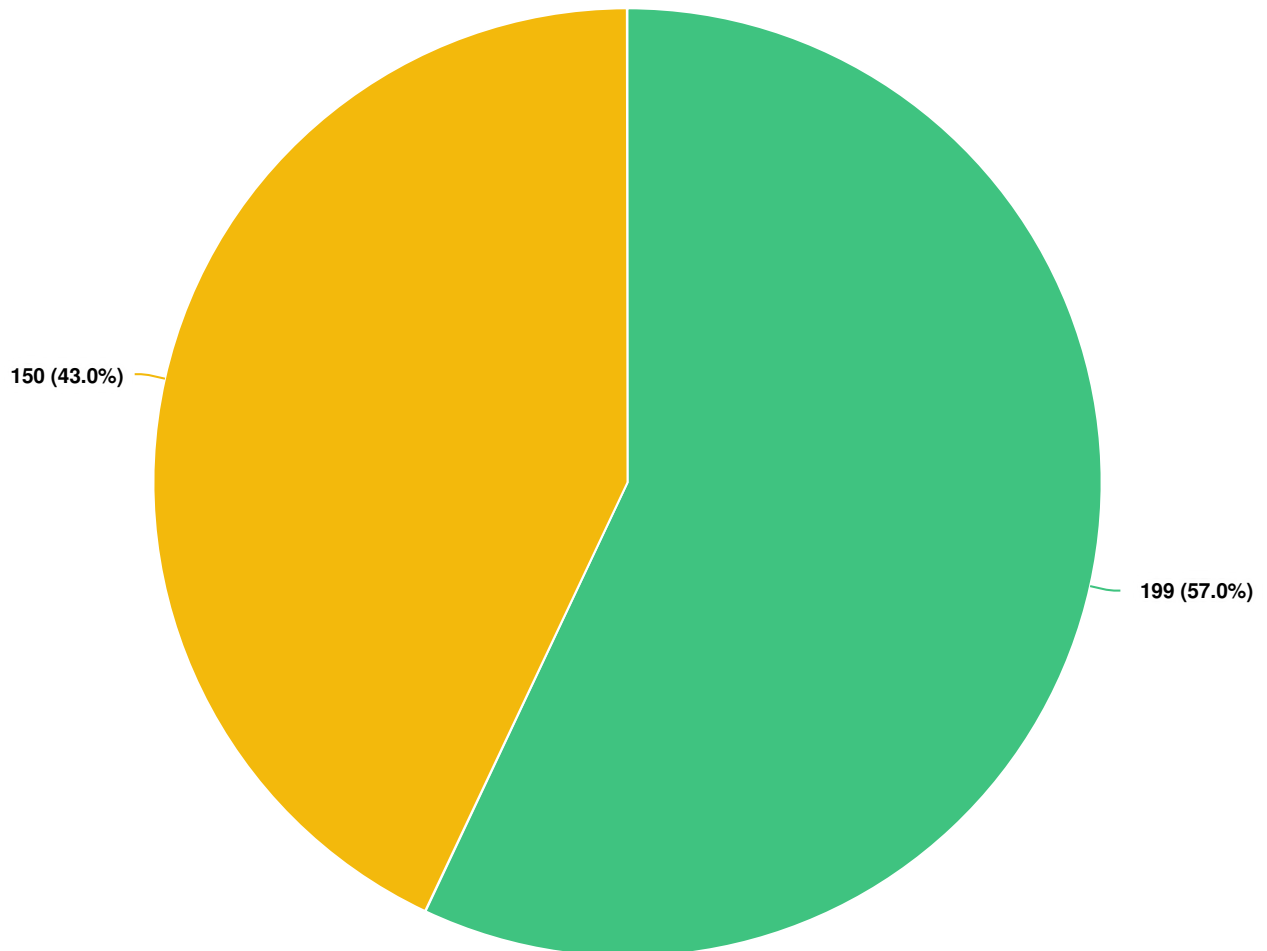

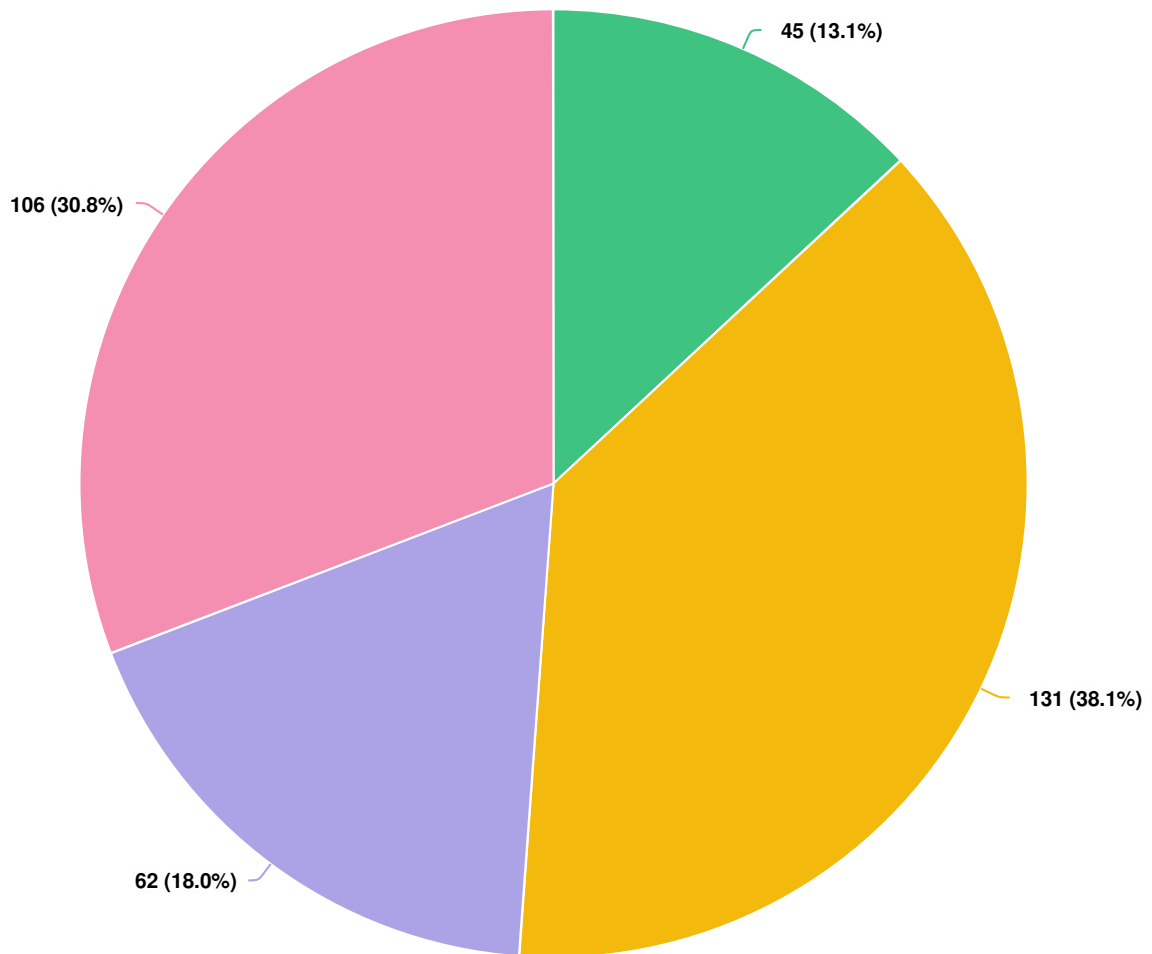

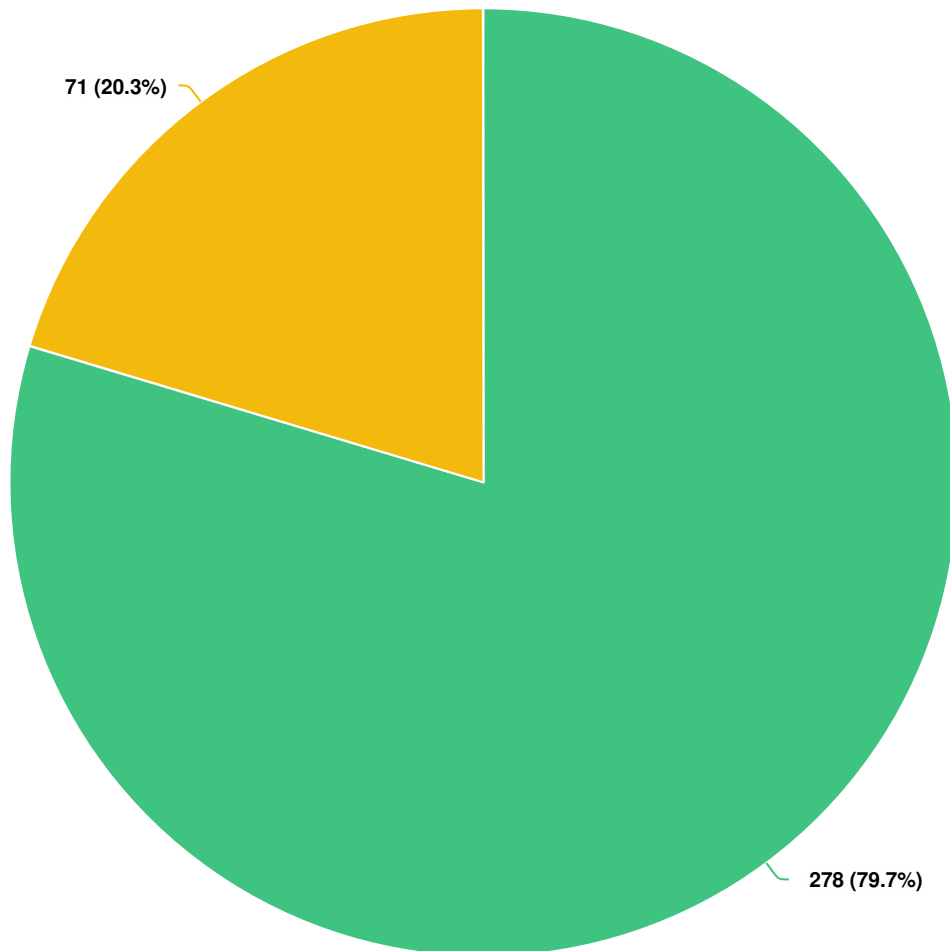

Q4 Public education is a fast-paced and evolving sector. Should the Board set reserves aside for future expenditures, like computers and other school equipment?

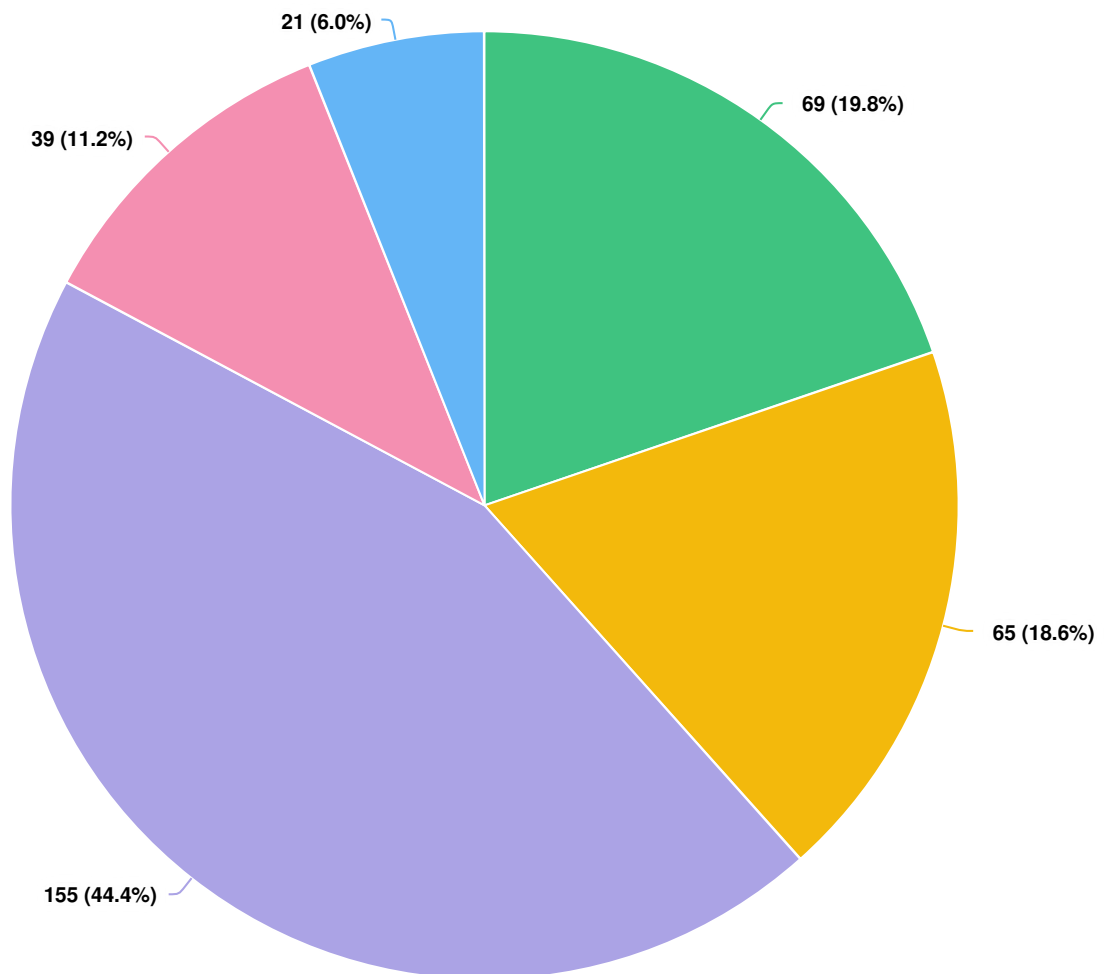

Q5 | Our accumulated surplus will decrease in 23-24 to \$5.6M from \$7.06M. It is then projected to remain stable for the coming two years.

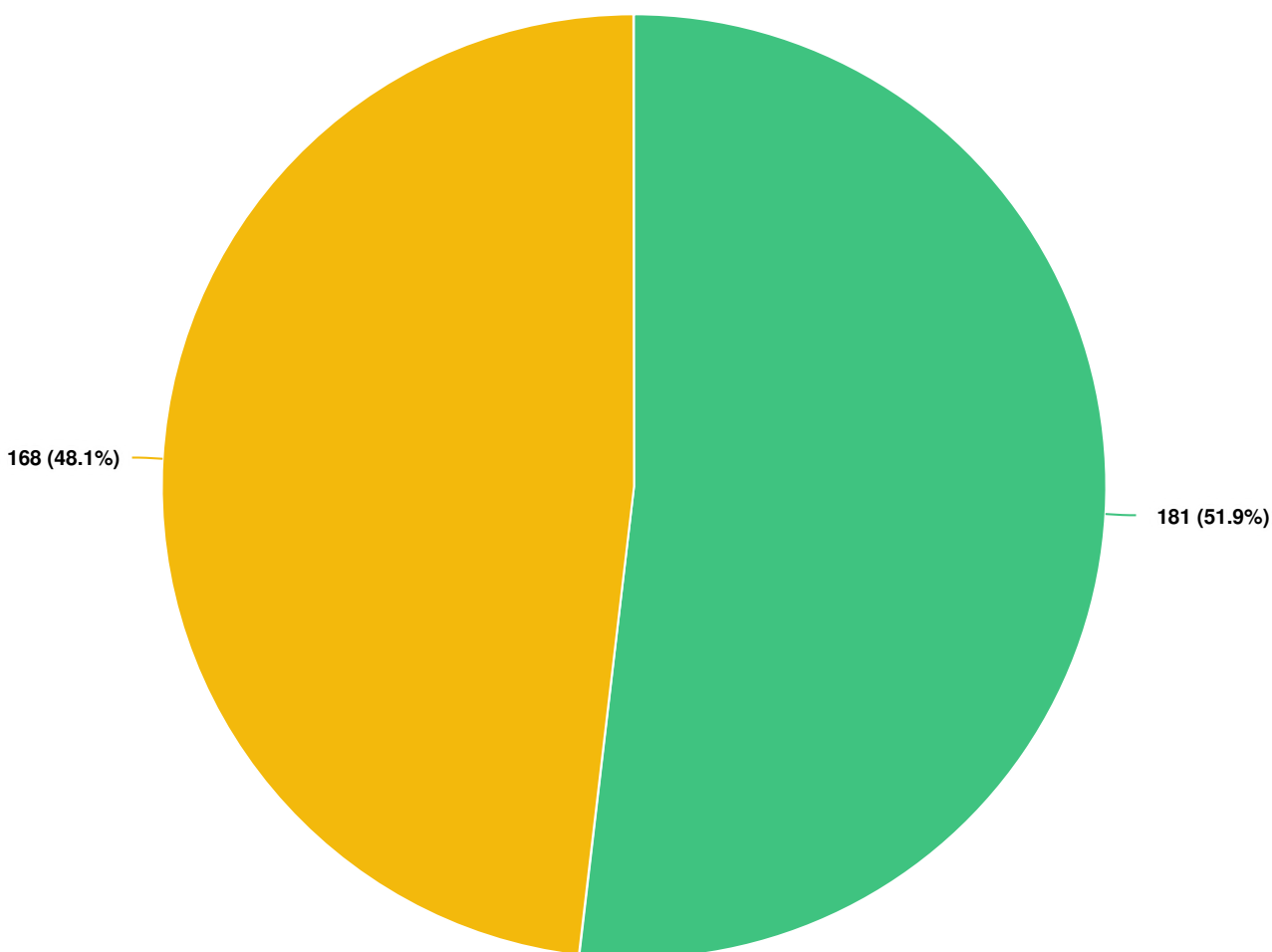
