7.0 DELEGATIONS/PRESENTATIONS/ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

7.1 School Presentations: Mathxwí & Terry Fox Elementary Schools

Acting Principal Nicolas Cochrane, teacher Mireille Strafford and students shared how Mathxwí Elementary is embracing their commitment to Truth and Reconciliation by learning a new word a week in Halq'eméylem and practicing that word all week long. Principal Kari Petzold shared information about the Roots of Empathy program currently running in one of their Kindergarten classes at Terry Fox Elementary. This program, which involves the entire school, is helping students develop their self-regulation skills.

7.2 2025 Community Matters Award

Superintendent Nosek announced that nominations for the 2025 Community Matters Award are open. The award will be presented in June as a way to formally recognize a community partner who has exceeded their community service mandate and has made a significant, deliberate contribution to Abbotsford School District Students.

8.1 Curriculum Department: Strategic Plan Progress Report

Tracy Krys, Director of Instruction, Curriculum provided an update to the Board on the progress made in the strategic plan's focus areas: Student Success and Engaging Opportunities. She reviewed the strategic objectives linked to the Curriculum Department's operational plan, highlighted key successes, discussed emerging needs, and presented future plans. These upcoming initiatives include continued support for early career teachers, the expansion of residency models, and efforts to strengthen community connections.

8.2 Learning Support Services Department: Strategic Plan Progress Report

Michelle Gehring, Director of Instruction, Learning Support Services, provided an update to the Board on the progress of the District's Strategic Plan, specifically regarding the strategic goals for Excellence in Teaching. The update focused on inclusive classrooms and highlighted key achievements and projects from the 2023-24 school year that support the department's strategies. Additionally, it included an overview of ongoing work for the 2024-25 school year.
