Re School Presentations – Barrowtown Elementary and Eugene Reimer Middle

BACKGROUND:

To deepen the understanding and connection between the Board's activities and the district's core mission of preparing students for a lifetime of success, *School Presentations* will serve as a standard feature at Public Board Meetings and are scheduled for the next two years. This strategic initiative provides a dynamic and interactive forum for our staff and students to showcase innovative work happening in our schools, highlighting how efforts contribute to student achievement and align with operational plans.

The following schools will be present at the May 2024 Public Board Meeting:

- **Barrowtown Elementary School:** In their presentation about their school's agriculture project, students will showcase the various projects underway on their school farm and how students learn through hands-on experiences. Principal Michelle Basran, Barrowtown staff and parents will accompany the students.
- **Eugene Reimer Middle School:** Currently, students are using a method for mathematical exploration that uses both the core competencies and curricular competencies. Students will demonstrate how they use mathematical strategies from the thinking classroom and will ask trustees to participate in a thinking classroom task.
