7.1 Observances & Holidays Acknowledgement

Chair Neufeld acknowledged International Women's Day, World Down Syndrome Day, International Day for the Elimination for Racial Discrimination and Transgender Day of Visibility.

7.2 Student Presentation: Terry Fox Elementary School – Terry's Team

Superintendent Godden welcomed Principal Magon and students from Terry Fox Elementary, who shared information about the new Grade 5 Service and Humanitarian Club "Terry's Team" The club raises money for different organizations and does kind things for the community, including the school community.

8.0 <u>REPORT ON ACHIEVEMENT/RESULTS</u>

8.1 2022 Summer Explorers and Secondary Summer School Program Reports

Superintendent Godden welcomed Assistant Superintendents Bondi and Danielsson who introduced the 2022 Summer School Leadership team – Michelle Basran, Deborah Chenier, Melanie Trudeau, Soraya Rajabally and Tom van Hunenstijn. The 2022 Leadership Team shared the big ideas and information about inquiry-based learning that had approximately 1,600 students engaged from July 4-28, 2022.

8.2 Local School Calendar for 2023-2024 – Notice of Motion

Superintendent Godden presented the revised calendar for 2023-2024 which the Abbotsford Teachers' Union (ATU) is in support of. The revised calendar is very similar to the proposed calendar, except that the early dismissal days have been changed to February 7 & 8 instead of February 14 & 15. The 2023-2024 proposed Local School Calendar was made available from February 15-February 28, 2023 for an opportunity for parents, students and stakeholder groups' input via an online survey.

8.3 K-12 Extra-Curricular Scan

Superintendent Godden welcomed Assistant Superintendent Ngieng who presented information about the district engaging in a detailed study of student engagement in extra-curricular activities to understand the landscape of extra-curricular activities for K-12. The environmental scan will take place during the Spring of 2023, with a report delivered to the school district by June 2023.

8.4 Framework for Enhancing Student Learning District Review

Superintendent Godden shared information about the recent meetings between our district and the Ministry Review Team and presented the draft Peer Feedback Report. The report will be used to guide the district's ongoing work.

8.6 New Administrative Procedure 116 - Privacy Management Program
