6.1 W.J. Mouat Secondary Artificial Turf Field Agreement

7.1 Second Quarter Financial Report

The Secretary-Treasurer presented the second quarter report noting the amended budget will be presented at the February 13th Public Board Meeting. Highlighted was the reduction in classroom substitute costs reduced from the prior year, and effects of the 6.75% wage increases.

7.2 Operating Grants Funding Recalculation

The Secretary-Treasurer provided an analysis of the impacts of the Ministry's operating grant announcement in December highlighting adjustments made to the budget based on revised enrolments. Discussion ensued on labour settlement funding and comments were made regarding unapproved new initiatives from June 30 to date versus cost pressure changes as will be outlined further in the amended annual budget which will be presented at the February 13th public board meeting.
